Potential candidates are offered full-time research-based Master's degree in Environmental Engineering whereby the core research activities will be carried out in AMTEC, UTM, Johor Bahru, Malaysia with a short-term attachment study in Japan. The consortium aims to develop the intellectual, practical and professional skills of individuals in term of critical data acquisition, analysis, interpretation and understanding of environmental principles and issues, specifically on water and wastewater treatment.

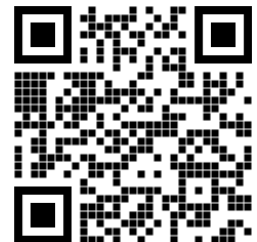

## APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- ❖ Applicant must be from ASEAN countries (except Brunei and Singapore). Priority will be given to non-Malaysian candidates
- ❖ Applicant is not receiving any scholarship at the time of recruitment
- ❖ Applicant must possess excellent English proficiency with:
  - minimum TOEFL score of 550 or TOEFL IBT 79
  - minimum IELTS score of 6.0

- ❖ Statement of purpose (one page)
- ❖ Curriculum vitae (CV) or resume
- ❖ Research proposal (5-10 pages, 1.5 line spacing)
- ❖ Official academic Bachelor's Degree transcripts
- ❖ English proficiency certificate (TOEFL, IELTS or equivalent)
- ❖ Copy of applicant's passport
- ❖ Two recommendation letters (at least one must come from a academic advisor/instructor)
- ❖ Recent photograph (1 × 1.5 inches, jpeg format)
- ❖ Abstract of Bachelor's thesis
- ❖ Research papers, publications or certificates (if any)
